

THE GLOSTER FANCY CANARY STANDARD

Scale of Points:

Corona: – Neatness; regular, unbroken round shape, eye discernible	15
With definite "centre".....	5
Consort: – Head broad and round at every point, with good rise over centre of skull	15
Eyebrow heavy, showing brow.....	5
Body: – Back well filled and wings laying closely thereto; full neck, chest nicely rounded, without prominence	20
Tail: – Closely folded and well carried	5
Plumage: – Close, firm, giving a clearcut appearance; of good quality and good natural colour.....	15
Carriage: – Alert and quick lively movement.....	10
Legs and Feet: – Medium length, without blemish	5
Size: – For tendency to the diminutive.....	15
Condition: – Health, cleanliness.....	10
TOTAL	100

The Gloster Canary has two counterparts - a Corona and a Consort.

Consort: A Canary bred to the true type of a Gloster with a plain head.

Corona: Otherwise a Consort Gloster Canary adorned with a crest which is termed a Corona.

LIGHT VARIEGATED shall mean not more than 25% dark feathering on total bird.

HEAVY VARIEGATED TO SELF shall mean any bird that shows more than 25% dark feathering.

THE STANDARD GLOSTER CANARY SHOW CAGE - Same as N.Z.C.C.B.S.


Glosters shall be exhibited in standard cage.
